Scholarship Application Rules & Guidelines

- 1. The Scholarship Application and Essay may be uploaded to the JCAC Website at: <u>http://www.dstjcac.org/scholarship.aspx</u> (Please see upload instructions). However, if you would prefer, you may mail your application and essay.
- 2. If uploading the Scholarship Application and Essay all other materials *must be* mailed.
- 3. *All* materials must be postmarked or time-stamped (Application and Essay) by Tuesday, February 19, 2012. Mail scholarship packet to:

- 4. Only official transcripts will be accepted.
- 5. Only the G.P.A. from the official transcripts will be used.
- 6. Letters of Recommendation and Transcripts may not be scanned and uploaded to the website.
- 7. Included in this application packet are Letter of Recommendation Guidelines in order to assist those who you will ask to write your Letter of Recommendations. It will be helpful if you print a copy for each of your recommenders to ensure all directions are followed and all information requested is included in each Letter of Recommendation.
- 8. Failure to follow any of the above instructions or to completely fill out the application will automatically disqualify you from the next phase in the Scholarship Application process.

Letter of Recommendation Guidelines

- 1. Letter of Recommendation Forms **will not** be accepted. Letters of Recommendation must be in a letter form.
- 2. Two letters of recommendations (categories: teacher, counselor, minister, community service organization, or employer) Letters must be written by two *different* people from two *different* categories listed.
- 3. Letters *must be* written on the official letterhead of organization being represented.
- 4. Recommender must include their title and in what capacity they have known the applicant. If recommender knows the applicant in more than one capacity (i.e. teacher *and* band director) they must state both capacities in the letter.
- 5. The Letter of Recommendation must include the following:
 - Leadership qualities and characteristics
 - Personal qualities and characteristics
 - □ In what capacity do they know the student (i.e., teacher, pastor, counselor, supervisor, mentor, etc.)
 - Affiliations inside *and* outside of school and leadership positions held within those organizations
- 6. Letters that do not include all of the requested information or fails to follow any of the above instructions will automatically disqualify you from the next phase in the Scholarship Application process.

Scholarship Application and Essay Upload Instructions

- 1. It is not mandatory to upload your scholarship application and essay.
- 2. If you upload your scholarship application and essay, the files must be uploaded to: <u>http://www.dstjcac.org/scholarship.aspx</u>.
- 3. You must save your scholarship application as LastName_FirstName_Application.pdf
- 4. You must save your essay as LastName_FirstName_Essay.pdf. You must also include your name on your essay in the header.
- 5. Enter your First Name, Last Name and Email Address. Select your application file to upload. Select your essay file to upload. Then, press Submit Application & Essay button. You will receive a confirmation email of receipt of your application and essay being received. Once your application and essay are submitted, you will not be able to make any corrections.
- 6. Letters of Recommendation and Transcripts may not be scanned and uploaded to the website.
- 7. Failure to follow any of the above instructions will automatically disqualify you from the next phase in the Scholarship Application process.
